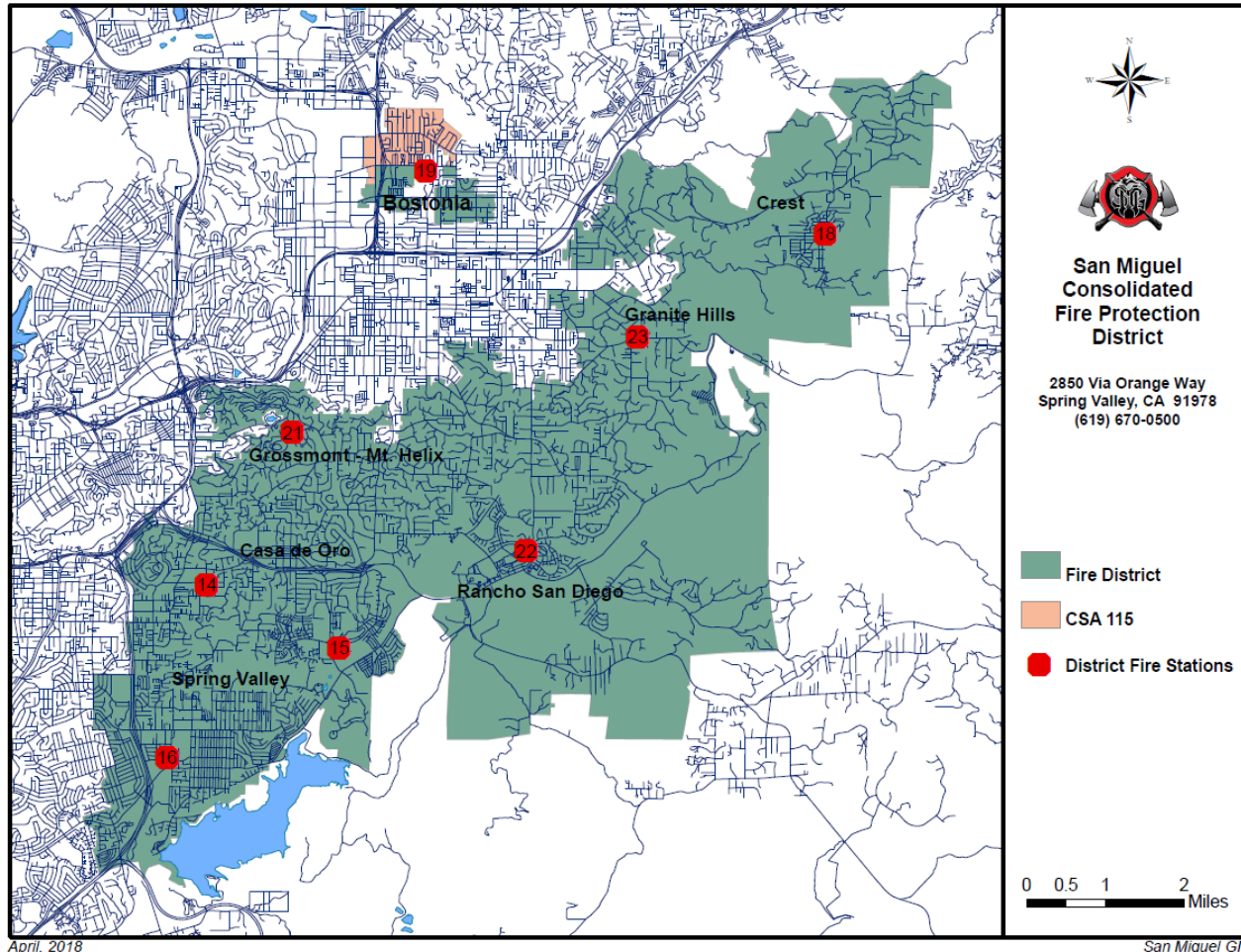

ABOUT SAN MIGUEL

San Miguel Consolidated Fire Protection District is one of the largest Fire Districts in San Diego County, operating on a projected budget of \$21,512,800 for Fiscal Year 2020/2021 and serving approximately 140,000 residents over 50 square miles in the communities of Bostonia, Casa de Oro, Crest, Grossmont/Mt. Helix, La Presa, Rancho San Diego, Spring Valley and the unincorporated areas of El Cajon and La Mesa.

San Miguel's 80 full-time employees provide suppression, prevention and emergency medical services. In 2019, our suppression force will respond to over 13,000 fire and medical-related emergencies.

Crews respond to a wide variety of calls covering various commercial and industrial operations, single-family residences, large multi-unit apartments and condominium projects, and an extensive urban/wildland interface area.



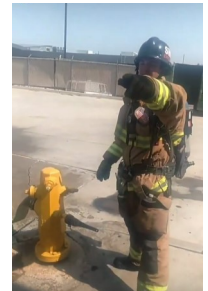
BECOMING AN EXPLORER

Minimum requirements for San Miguel's Explorer Program:

- Be between 14 and 21 years old
(Completion of 8th grade required)
- Maintain a GPA of at least 2.5
